Lost River Cave is an urban 70-acre park that offers activities and events that utilize its natural and man-made features. Natural features include the cave; a wooded valley with trails, river, and other karst features such as blue holes and sinking streams; and a 20-acre restored prairie. Man-made features include Flying Squirrel Zipline, a constructed wetland, the paved greenway trail, the visitor center, and the gift shop. Alumni College attendees can participate in the trail and cave boat tour as well as the zipline, where guests can fly through the treetops and zip over the valley's largest blue hole surrounded by breathtaking natural beauty. Enjoy an afternoon outdoors in one of Kentucky's natural wonders.
